DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply only as directed. For use on turf and in gardens. The pellets in this product disperse into the soil to reduce soil acidity. For best results, determine the pH levels of the area to be treated by conducting a soil test. If that information is not available, refer to the recommendations below on rates and timing.

When establishing a new turf area, apply 40 lbs per 1,000 sq. ft. prior to seeding. Rake lightly into the soil. Water well after application.

For established turf areas, apply 20-40 lbs per 1,000 sq. ft.

To maintain proper pH soil levels, or when the soil pH level drops below 6.3, repeat application 1 to 2 times per year, at rates of 4-6 lbs per 1,000 sq. ft.

To correct pH levels, 4 lbs per 1,000 sq. ft. for every 2/10 pH correction needed, not to exceed 40 lbs per 1,000 sq. ft. per application. Gardens have a deeper root zone and require a higher application rate than turf. For best results, double the turf recommended rates and mix into the soil at a depth of 6 inches.
