- Do not collect clippings for at least one mowing following application to avoid particle pick-up.

Cool Season Grasses:

- Apply at the RECOMMENDED RATE.

Warm Season Grasses:

- Apply at the RECOMMENDED RATE every 4-6 weeks during the period of active growth.
