The Andersons New Lawn Starter is formulated to help new lawns grow quicker and thicker. This formula contains quick- and slow-release nitrogen to give quick response and then steady feeding of nitrogen that promotes top growth of the grass. Phosphate is essential in the development of deep, strong roots. Potash thickens the wall structure of the grass and makes the grass more vigorous. Sulfur helps maintain the dark green color of your grass and also helps encourages more vigorous plant and root growth. Iron prevents yellowing by aiding the development of chlorophyll in the grass.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE



SPREAD PRODUCT

For new lawn seed or sod, apply at the recommended rate. Work into soil 2- 3 inches deep, before spreading seed or laying sod. Keep soil moist until seeds germinate. Do not allow soil to dry out.



CLEAN-UP

Sweep any product on driveways and sidewalks back onto your lawn. Return any unused material back into the original package. This product may stain. **Do not wash with water.**



WATER IN

To help move the particles into soil more quickly, water with a minimum of 0.2 inches. For best results, water the lawn every 12 hours for the next 48 hours. Skip watering if rain occurs.



STORAGE

Store left over product in a clean, dry place. Reseal opened bag by folding top down and securing.



PRO TIPS FOR ESTABLISHED LAWNS

- Mow before applying
- Do not apply prior to heavy rainfall to avoid particles getting washed away
- Do not collect clippings for a least one mowing to avoid particle pick-up
- Can be applied every 6-8 weeks during the growing season

SPREADER SETTINGS

This bag is designed to deliver 3.6 lbs. of product per 1,000 sq. ft., for a total coverage of 5,000 sq. ft. Settings are based on an average walking speed of 3 mph. Reduce setting for a lower speed; raise setting for higher speed.
