HEALTH EFFECTS: Causes eye, skin, and respiratory irritation. May cause an allergic skin reaction. Harmful if swallowed.

CARCINOGENICITY: 2,4-dichlorophenoxyacetic acid is classified as "possibly carcinogenic to humans" (Group 2B). The product may contain trace amounts of crystalline silica, which is listed by IARC as a potential human carcinogen.

ORAL: > 100 mg/kg (2,4-dichlorophenoxyacetic acid) – 14,300 mg/kg (urea)

DERMAL: > 900 mg/kg (mecoprop) – 2,000 mg/kg (dicamba)
